

# See God's BLESSINGS to LUTHERAN HIGH SCHOOL

† Lutheran High offers students the option to participate in college credit programs affiliated with St. Louis University and Lindenwood University. Students in these programs may earn over 25 college credits while in high school. LHS also offers AP Classes in Calculus, Literature, Psychology and Comparative Government.

† LHS has a resource specialist on campus to work with students with diagnosed learning disabilities, attention deficit disorder, or other educational challenges.

† The student/faculty ratio at LHS is 14 to 1. Academic classes at LHS average 18 to 23 students per class.

† A total of 26 different athletes from Lutheran High received All-State recognition over the last three years in the following sports: Football, Girls Volleyball, Wrestling, Boys and Girls Track, and Boys Golf.

† Lutheran High students are afforded numerous opportunities for volunteer service in their church and community through involvement in clubs, organizations and theology classes.

† Lutheran High fields competitive teams in the following sports: Varsity, J.V. & Freshmen Football; Varsity & J.V. Boys Soccer; Varsity, J.V. & Freshmen Volleyball; Softball; Boys and Girls Cross Country; Varsity and J.V. Wrestling; Varsity, J.V. & Freshmen Boys Basketball; Varsity, J.V. & Freshmen Girls Basketball; Varsity & J.V. Girls Soccer, Varsity & J.V. Baseball, Boys Golf, Boys and Girls Tennis, and Boys and Girls Track and Field.

† Active programs exist in Cheerleading, Pommers, Student Council, National Honor Society, Kingdom Workers, Thespians, Teens for Life, Sister Cities Program, Book Club, Art Club, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Photography Club, Creative Writing, and Future Business Leaders of America.

† The Girls Basketball Team won Districts 4 of the last 6 years and finished 2nd in State Class 3A in 2005. The Girls Volleyball Team has gone to the Final Four at State four of the last five years. They finished 2nd in Class 3A in 2006 and won the State Championship in Class 2A for 2004. The Girls Track Team finished 2nd in State Class 2A in 2004 and 2005.

† The Class of 2008 had an average ACT composite score of 24.6 compared to 21.6 for the state and 21.1 nationally. Through its 27 year history, 94% of Lutheran High graduates have entered college after graduation, over 75% choosing 4 year colleges.

† The LHS Choir and Band perform three concerts per year, participate in District Solo, Choir, and Band Festivals, and take a four day tour through the Midwest.

† The Lutheran High Scholarship Endowment is presently at \$275,000 and growing. 80% of the earnings are used each year to provide financial assistance to students attending LHS. This year that amounted to \$6,200 in financial aid.

† The Class of 2008 had 95 graduates with 90 headed to college and between them they accepted scholarships and grants valued at over \$1,700,000. They enrolled in 39 different colleges located in 15 different states and 1 in Canada.

† Lutheran High has consistently had students selected to the Missouri Scholar's Academy and the Missouri Fine Arts Academy.

† LHS has students selected each year to All-District Band and All-District Choir. The LHS Band received a 1-Rating in state competition in 2004. Choir received 1-Rating at state in 2005 and again in 2007.

† LHS Cross Country Teams have sent runners to State five of the last six years. The Wrestlers have sent 19 to State over the last three years with 4 placing. In 2006 both Girls and Boys Track took 2nd in Districts with four girls and five boys qualifying for State.

† Over the last four years 29 graduates of Lutheran High have chosen to attend colleges or universities of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, the majority training to serve the church in full-time church worker careers (pastors, teachers, DCE's, music directors, etc.)

† LHS and Lutheran Association for Special Education cooperate to provide the Jeremiah program for certain developmentally delayed students, which allows for partial inclusion in the school's academic program, while maintaining careful watch over their learning process in a highly individualized program.

† 89% of the LHS student body is involved in some co-curricular program at school.

† Lutheran High has completed a new athletic complex including new team locker rooms for boys and girls, a new weight room, a new playing field with lights, stadium seating, an 8-lane synthetic track, press box, a concession stand, additional parking, and a new practice field.

† LHS operates a tuition assistance program for students with demonstrated financial need and awarded over \$57,000 in tuition grants this year.

† A Power School Program allows students and parents to have continuous access to their class grades, attendance, and the daily bulletin through the internet.

† The Class of 2008 had eleven students with composite ACT scores of 31 or more. 45 of the 95 students in the class graduated with Honors or High Honors.

† The staff of 29 teachers at LHS average more than 19 years experience and over 79% of them have earned a Master's Degree.

† Lutheran High puts a special emphasis on developing the Christian character of their students and has selected to emphasize "respect" for the 2008-09 school year.

† The Drama Department puts on three productions a year and has an active Thespian Chapter that participates in state workshops and conferences.
